

Kimball City Council
Regular Meeting
August 17, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was convened in open and public session at 6:00 p.m. on August 17, 2021, held at the Kimball County Transit building, 233 S. Chestnut St. Council members Pike, Bright, Ingram and Warner were present. Mayor was not present. Also, present was City Attorney Turman, Deputy Clerk Barnwell. The public was represented.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in the Western Nebraska Observer. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is on record at the office of the City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public except as otherwise indicated.

Pike called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Bright, Ingram, Pike and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Mayor Prunty. Motion carried. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Pike acknowledged the posted Open Meetings Act.

Pike opened discussion on Current Business. Tim Nolting with Plains Historical Society was present and did a brief oral presentation promoting the Smithsonian exhibit that will be coming to Kimball on September 11 at 9:00 am by the caboose. The exhibit will remain in Kimball for the month of September 2021. Mr. Nolting personally invited the Councilman and Mayor Prunty to attend the for opening ceremony. The exhibit will be visiting seven other cities in Nebraska with Kimball as the first stop.
