

Kimball City Council  
2021-2022 FY Budget Adoption Hearing  
September 13, 2021

A public budget adoption hearing meeting of the Mayor and City Council was convened in open and public session at 6:00 p.m. on September 13, 2021, held in the city council chambers, 223 S. Chestnut St. Council members Pike, Bright, Ingram and Warner were present. Also, present was City Clerk/Treasurer Brower and Deputy Treasurer Klassen. The public was represented.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in the Western Nebraska Observer. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is on record at the office of the City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public except as otherwise indicated.

Prunty called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Prunty, Bright, Ingram, Pike and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: None. Motion carried. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Prunty acknowledged the posted Open Meetings Act.

Prunty opened the public hearing for the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget at 6:01 p.m. No comments received from the public. Prunty closed the public hearing at 6:02 p.m.

Prunty opened the public hearing for the setting of the final property tax request for the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget at 6:02 p.m. No comments received from the public. Prunty closed the public hearing at 6:03 p.m.

Prunty opened discussion on the consideration of the restricted fund lid of 2.5%, as well as, the additional 1% increase in the restricted funds authority. Motion by Warner and seconded by Bright to approve the 2.5% restricted fund lid and the additional 1% increase in the restricted funds authority. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Bright, Ingram, Pike and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Prunty opened discussion on Resolution #2021-10 Setting of 2021-2022 Property Tax Request. Ingram motioned and second by Pike to approve Resolution 2021-10 Setting Property Tax Request. Prunty opened discussion on Ordinance #795 for the 2021-2022 Budget Appropriations. Motion by Warner and seconded by Ingram to waive the three readings of Ordinance #795. Motion made by Pike and seconded by Bright to approve Ordinance 795 2021-2022 FY Budget Appropriations. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Bright, Ingram, Pike and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.
