Special Meeting to Approve 2022-2023 Budget
and Public Hearing on Annexation
September 23, 2022

A Special Meeting to Approve 2022-2023 Budget and Public Hearing on Annexation of the Mayor and City Council was convened in open and public session at 5:00 p.m. on September 23, 2022, held at the Kimball County Transit building, 233 S. Chestnut St. Council members Ingram, Pike, and Warner were present. Also, present was Mayor Prunty, City Administrator Brower, City Attorney Turman, and City Treasurer Klassen. The public was represented.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in the Western Nebraska Observer. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is on record at the office of the City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public except as otherwise indicated.

Prunty called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Prunty acknowledged the posted Open Meetings Act.

Prunty opened for a motion to excuse the absence of Council member Bright. Ingram moved and seconded by Pike to excuse the absence of Council member Bright. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

Prunty opened public hearing at 5:01 p.m. for application for City Council Ordinance No. 806. An ordinance of the City Council of the City of Kimball, Nebraska to annex to the City of Kimball certain lands described herein which are located within Kimball County, Nebraska, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith; and to provide that this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form. No public comments were made. Prunty closed the public hearing at 5:01 p.m.

Prunty opened discussion and receive recommendation from Planning Commission regarding Annexation Resolution #2022-10.

Prunty opened discussion and approval for City Council Ordinance No. 806. An ordinance of the City Council of the City of Kimball, Nebraska to annex to the City of Kimball certain lands described herein which are located within Kimball County, Nebraska, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith; and to provide that this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form. Motion by Ingram and seconded by Pike to introduce ordinance number 806, read by title only, pass first reading and extend passage to a future meeting. On roll call the following votes were recorded. After discussion, Pike moved and seconded by Ingram to approve Resolution 2022-12 for Intent to Annex Property Adjacent and Contiguous to the City of Kimball. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Ingram – yes, Pike – yes, Warner – Abstained, Prunty – yes. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

Prunty opened consideration and approval on the Restricted Fund Lid and the Additional One Percent. Warner moved and seconded by Ingram to approve the Restricted Fund Lid and the Additional One Percent. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

Prunty opened discussion and approval on Resolution 2022-13, Setting Tax Request FY 2022-2023. Warner moved and seconded by Pike to approve Resolution 2022-13, Setting Tax Request FY 2022-2023. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

Prunty opened discussion and approval on Ordinance #808, 2022-2023 Budget Appropriations. Warner moved to approve Ordinance #808, read by title only and the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Seconded by Ingram. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

Ingram moved and seconded by Pike to approve Ordinance #808, 2022-2023 Budget Appropriations. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Ingram moved and seconded by Pike to adjourn the meeting at 5:08 p.m. On roll call the following votes were recorded. Aye: Ingram, Pike, and Warner. Nay: None. Absent: Bright. Motion carried.
