## PLEASE BE AWARE!

### PIPES CAN FREEZE AT 10° OR COLDER

The City of Kimball suggests that you leave a small stream of cold water running:

- ◆ At night
- ◆ When you will be gone for an extended time
- ◆ When no water is being used

When it is 10° or colder, a stream of water about the size of a pencil lead should be enough to keep a pipe from freezing and bursting.

A new water meter is the customer's responsibility and repairs can cost \$\$\$\$

## 2023 Dog Licenses are Due

Any owner of a dog over the age of 6 months is required to purchase a license for the dog annually by or before May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. The current license fees are:



	Prior to May 1 <sup>st</sup>	After May 1st
Neutered/Spayed	\$5.00	\$6.00
Not Neutered/Spayed	\$8.00	\$9.00

.At the time the application for license is made, the owner will be required to provide a copy of the certificate of rabies vaccination effective for the ensuing year of the license.

An owner of dogs may have no more than 4 dogs per residence. A kennel license is required for over 4 dogs and different requirements must be met.

### Just a Reminder . . .

#### Severe Weather Suspension of Disconnection

The City of Kimball will suspend disconnection of service due to non-payment to all residential customers under the following weather conditions:

- Winter – Disconnection is suspended any time the average temperature for the next 24 or 48 hours is forecasted to be 32 degrees or below
- Summer – Disconnection is suspended any time the average heat index is forecasted to be 105 degrees or higher at any point during the next 24 or 48 hour period.
- Late and/or weather-related fees will apply.

### For Your Information: Late Fees, Reconnect Fees and Shut-Offs

1. A \$25.00 utility late fee will be charged on any account not paid by the utility bill due before date listed on the customer's final (courtesy) notice or agreed upon terms for payment agreements. If not paid, the services will be shut off until payment is received.
2. A \$25.00 reconnect fee, plus tax, will be charged to reconnect utilities before 4:30 PM on normal business days.
3. A \$75.00 reconnect fee, plus tax, will be charged to reconnect utilities after 4:30 PM on normal business days, weekends, and holidays.
