94.50 Requirement to Keep Clean

It shall be unlawful for the occupant of any lot or lots or the owner of any vacant lot or lots within the corporate limits to allow snow, sleet, mud, ice, or other substance to accumulate on the sidewalks or to permit any snow, sleet, mud, ice or other substance to remain upon the sidewalk. Unless the City Council has provided otherwise, all sidewalks within the business district shall be cleaned within 5 hours after the cessation of a storm, unless the storm or fall of snow shall have taken place during the night, in which case, the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 9:00 AM the following day. Sidewalks within the residential areas of the city shall be cleaned within 24 hours after the cessation of the storm.

2023 Dog Licenses are Due

Any owner of a dog over the age of 6 months is required to purchase a license for the dog annually by or before May 1st of each year. The current license fees are:



	After May 1st	Prior to May 1 st
Neutered/Spayed	\$5.00	\$6.00
Not Neutered/Spayed	\$8.00	\$9.00

At the time the application for license is made, the owner will be required to provide a copy of the certificate of rabies vaccination effective for the ensuing year of the license.

An owner of dogs may have no more than 4 dogs per residence. A kennel license is required for over 4 dogs and different requirements must be met.
