Annual Free Pick-Up



April 17 to April 28

Beginning Monday, April 17th through Friday, April 28, the City of Kimball will

pick up and haul away your unwanted items for free. Items need to be outside in the alley or by the curb for pick-up.

This includes appliances, tree branches, metal, wooden pallets and furniture. Paint can be disposed of only if it has dried (no liquid).

This service is limited to City residents only and a form must be filled out, signed, and turned in.

Choice Gas Selection Period is April 6-26

The 2023 Nebraska Choice Gas program selection period will run from April 6 through April 26. During this period, natural gas customers can choose their natural gas supplier and pricing option for the upcoming gas year, which begins June 1 and runs through May 31, 2024.

ACE, the only community-owned natural gas supplier in the program, is celebrating it's 25th year as a competing supplier this year. At the direction of the ACE Board, ACE returns money to its member communities, which includes the City of Kimball. ACE has returned more than \$74,000 to Kimball for community betterment use.

Formed by Nebraska communities to ensure competition and to serve as a customer advocate, ACE offers several pricing options and encourages customers to actively choose a supplier. Pricing during the selection period is available on ACE's website: www.ACEenergy.org or by calling (808) 454-4759.
