City ordinance 96.19 requires property owners to keep limbs and branches cut over sidewalks and streets or alleys. Branches should be 10 ft above sidewalks and 15 ft. above streets or alleys.

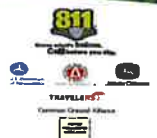
