- Owners are responsible for dog messes & all dogs must have one handler
- In addition to the big pool, our baby pool will be available for small or nervous dogs. We require that all dogs be willing swimmers.
 Forcing a nervous or scared dog into the pool will NOT be tolerated.
- Dogs must be on a leash outside of the water.
- Handlers will not be allowed in the water unless the dog needs assistance.

All Participating Pups must be friendly, social, well mannered, and have UPDATED PROOF OF VACCINATIONS to be presented to pool staff.
